

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT™
BETWEEN
WICHITA STATE UNIVERSITY AND ALLEN COMMUNITY COLLEGE
May 28, 2015
Revised February 17, 2017

The purpose of this Articulation Agreement is to provide learning opportunities provided through the University of Wyoming for students to earn regards to the Allen Community College Associate of Applied Science in Early Childhood Education program, pursuing a Bachelor of Science in Early Childhood Education at the University of Wyoming. This agreement will be effective for all students enrolling for the first time.

Students should refer to transfer sheets for the required courses at least 60 hours of courses will be required for a 145 semester from Wichita State University.

The following criminal justice courses must be completed with a minimum grade of C- and earned A/A in Criminal Justice. This depicts a minimum of 15 credits.

Summary:

- 21 Hours of Criminal Justice courses taken at Allen
 - 15 credit hours of criminal justice courses taken at WSU
 - Total Criminal Justice Credit Hours 36
 - May take up to 14 additional elective hours in Criminal Justice to meet the total credit requirement
 - 6 credit hours of correlate core courses taken at WSU unless taken at Allen (see above "Correlate Core Course Requirements")
 - Students must also enter the Binghamton Guide to a Major as well as complete the English language requirement, and the university's requirements for their Bachelor's degree.
