



2+2 Articulation Agreement Between

Wichita State University and Butler Community College

March 27, 2019

The purpose of this 2+2 articulation agreement is to provide an opportunity to transfer coursework from Butler Community College to Wichita State University.

This agreement is for Butler students who have:

- Earned an Associates of Arts (A.A.) or Associates of Science (A.S.) degree
- Achieved a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0
- Applied for admission to WSU

Butler students who will:

- Be guaranteed to receive a letter of admission and receipt of transcripts
- Enter with junior status toward a baccalaureate degree
- Be guaranteed to transfer all credits (100 level and higher) up to but not exceeding 64 credits earned at Butler with a grade of C or better

Students can inquire about academic and financial aid opportunities and grants by contacting the WSU Office (316) 322-6404.

For graduation from WSU with a Bachelor of Science in Criminal Justice, students will need to fulfill transfer coursework from Butler along with all WSU degree requirements, degree requirements, and must meet all requirements outlined by WSU.

Students who meet the necessary requirements for admission to WSU, and will have their transcripts evaluated on an individual basis.
