



WICHITA STATE UNIVERSITY AND COWLEY COLLEGE 2+2 AGREEMENT Associates of Arts Degree / Bachelor's Degree in Business Administration July 2018

The purpose of the 2+2 Agreement is to provide Cowley College students with an Associate of Arts degree at Cowley College and a Bachelor's Degree in Business Administration at Wichita State University (WSU). This agreement provides guidance for both parties in advising students.

This agreement:

- Earned an Associate of Arts (A.A.) degree at Cowley College.
- Achieved a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0.
- Applied for admission to WSU.

Cowley College students must:

- Be guaranteed admission to WSU with junior standing.
- Enter with junior standing toward a baccalaureate degree.
- Be guaranteed to transfer 60 credit hours from Cowley College to WSU.

This partnership:

- Expanded student program opportunities, course articulation understandings, and transfer coordination.
- Graduates will possess the technical skills and conceptual background, critical thinking and applied experiences to address the workforce needs for achieving the desired economic development in the State of Kansas.
- All students must complete all major, minor, and general education requirements appropriate to the program curricula at the degree granting institution in order to graduate.
- Students can inquire about academic and participation scholarships, financial aid, and grants.
- Students transferring to WSU from Cowley College who have not completed an A.A. must meet all requirements for admission to WSU.

In order to ensure a successful transition between institutions in this 2+2 agreement, students should refer to the required degree plans or stipulations of the Transfer Student Handbook. Transfer students must be complete at least 60 credit hours of upper-division work in order to qualify for graduation from Wichita State University. Students must have high

Reverse Transfer

Students, who transfer to Wichita State University after Cowley College, who have earned an associate degree, are eligible to reverse transfer to receive credit for the attainment of the Associates of Arts degree provided that at least 45 credit hours of college work have been completed and degree requirements are met.

Modification of Agreement

This agreement shall only be modified in writing with the mutual consent of both parties.

Terms of Agreement

The agreement will begin with the 2018-2019 academic year.

Termination of Agreement

Either party may terminate this agreement for any reason with a written notice from either party.

This agreement is a collaborative effort between the two institutions and any necessary additions to this agreement shall be made in writing and signed by both parties.


