



2 + 2 Articulation Agreement Wichita State University & Garden City Community College

for Teacher Apprenticeship (Early Childhood Unified & Elementary Education, Birth-5th grade) and Elementary Education Program, K-6th grade

The purpose of this 2 + 2 agreement is to provide Garden City Community College students an opportunity to earn an Associate of Arts (A.A.) or Associate of Science (A.S.) degree from Wichita State University (WSU) in the fields of Early Childhood Unified and Elementary Education, Birth-5th grade (TAPP) or Elementary Education, K-6th grade (for transfer to a four-year institution).

The 2 + 2 articulation agreement between Garden City Community College and Wichita State University will be in effect for two years. This document also includes a list of WSU courses to complete upon transfer to the four-year institution.

Teacher Apprenticeship Program (Online Program):

The agreement is for Garden City, CC students who:

- Earned an Associate of Arts (A.A.) or Associate of Science (A.S.) degree
- Achieved a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0
- Employed as a para educator at the ECUE or grade level with instructional responsibilities within an interrelated or regular education setting (Kansas State Department of Health & Environment) or a similar setting
- Applied for admission to WSU as a transfer student or adult learner
- Completed program administration requirements (available at www.wichita.edu/education) to the Teacher Apprenticeship Program

Students considered an adult learner or transfer student based on WSU admission requirements have the option to be dual enrolled in the TAPP Program at Garden City Community College while completing their general education course requirements at Garden City Community College or their A.A. or A.S. degree following the TAPP program.

Garden City Community College students meeting the admission requirements for the program will:

- Be guaranteed admission to WSU upon receipt of transcripts
- Enter with junior status towards a baccalaureate degree
- Meet WSU General Education Policy or KBCOR policy
- Be guaranteed to transfer credits (100 level and higher), up to but not exceeding 60 credits with an earned grade of C or better for general education courses or higher for the other general education courses or higher for the other general education courses on the program of study

OR

Elementary Education, K-6th grade (On-Campus)

The agreement is for Garden City CC students who have:

- Earned an Associate of Arts (A.A.) or Associate of Science (A.S.) degree
- Achieved a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0
- Applied for admission to WSU

Garden City CC students meeting the admission requirements for the on-campus program will:

- Be guaranteed admission to WSU upon receipt of transcripts
- Enter with junior status towards a baccalaureate degree
- Meet WSU General Education Policy or KBCOR policy
- Be guaranteed to transfer credits (100 level and higher), up to but not exceeding 60 credits with an earned grade of C or better for general education courses or higher for the other general education courses or higher for the other general education courses on the program of study
- Earn 131 credit hours if they choose to complete the on-campus K-6th degree program. The Elementary Education, K-6th degree program at WSU requires a minimum of 130 credit hours, but because of general education requirements at this agreement will result in 131 credit hours earned
